# The "Get Started With Office Live" add-in window appears every time that you start certain 2007 Microsoft Office system applications

Problem description

When you start Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, or Microsoft PowerPoint, the "Get Started With Office Live" window appears. To make sure that this window does not appear again, you check the **Do not show me this message again** check box and then click the Close button. However, the window still appears every time that you start Word, Excel, or PowerPoint.

To have us fix this problem for you, go to the "Fix it for me" section. To fix this problem yourself, go to the "Let me fix it myself" section.

Fix it for me

To fix this problem automatically, click the **Fix this problem** link. Click **Run** in the **File Download** dialog box, and follow the steps in this wizard.

Note This automatic fix works for all languages. However, for some languages, the wizard text may be in English.

**Note** If you are not on the computer that has the problem, save the automatic fix to a flash drive or to a CD and then run it on the computer that has the problem. Next, go to the "Did this fix the problem?" section.

Let me fix it myself

## Windows XP and Windows Server 2003 users follow these steps:

- ${\bf 1.} \ \ {\bf Log} \ {\bf on} \ {\bf to} \ {\bf Windows} \ {\bf with} \ {\bf a} \ {\bf user} \ {\bf account} \ {\bf that} \ {\bf has} \ {\bf this} \ {\bf issue}.$
- 2. Click **Start**, click **Run**, type regedit on the **Open** box, and then click **OK**.
- 3. On the left pane expand HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER, expand Software, select Microsoft.
- 4. On the Edit menu point to New, and then select Key.
- 5. Type **OfficeLive** for the key name, and then press ENTER.
- 6. Close the Registry Editor
- 7. Start Word, Excel, or PowerPoint. When you see the "Get Started with Office Live" window, make sure the "Do not show me this message again" optionis checked, and then click Continue.
- 8. When you close the 2007 Microsoft Office System application, the registry values will be created for that user.

Note Additional users will only need to select the option Do not show me this message again.

# Windows Vista and Windows Vista Server 2008 users follow these steps:

- $1. \;\; \text{Log}$  on to Windows using a user account that has this issue.
- 2. Click **Start**, type *regedit* in the **Start Search** box.
- 3. Right-click regedit.exe in the Programs list, and then select Run as administrator.
- 4. On the left pane, expand HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER, expand Software, and then select Microsoft.
- 5. On the Edit menu point to New, and then select Key.
- 6. Type **OfficeLive** for the key name, and then press ENTER.
- 7. Close the Registry Editor
- 8. Start Word, Excel, or PowerPoint. When you see the **Get Started with Office Live** window, make sure that the **Do not show me this message again** optionis checked, and then click **Continue**.
- When you close the 2007 Microsoft Office system application, the registry values will be created for that user.

Note Additional users will only need to select the option Do not show me this message again.
